DOEACC Society

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DOEACC Society opens Regional Office at Pudukkottai, Tamil Nadu

The DOEACC Society has opened a Regional Office at Pudukkottai, Tamil Nadu. The setting up of the Regional Office shall facilitate the coordination of activities of the DOEACC Scheme, especially in the southern region of the country.

The Regional Office was inaugurated by Shri Su. Thirunavukkarasar, Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications and Information Technology on 18th October 2003. Shri Lakshmi Narayanan, IAS, Additional Secretary to the Govt. of India, Department of Information Technology, Shri Durai Divyanathan, Chairman, Pudukkottai Municipality, Dr. P.N. Gupta, Executive Director, DOEACC Society, Dr. Murali Krishna Kumar, Director, Department of IT, Govt. of India and Dr. G.M. Ajit, Director, DOEACC Centre. Kozikod were some of the notable dignitaries at the inaugural ceremony.

The Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications and IT, Shri Su. Thirunavukkarasar, in his inaugural address explained the concept of setting up of a Regional Office at Pudukkottai and extended his appreciation to the Department of Information Technology and DOEACC Society for giving shape to the plan. The Hon'ble Minister enlightened the gathering with the details of the 'quality' services of the DOEACC Society and emphasized the need to sustain the phenomenal growth in Software Exports.

Dr. G.M. Ajit, Regional Director, DOEACC Society proposed the vote of thanks. The inaugural function concluded with the singing of the National Anthem.

Eligibility Criteria for O, A, B Level Practical Examinations

Eligibility and Exemptions from Practical Examination:

All the candidates clearing a particular qualification viz. 'O', 'A' or 'B' under the revised syllabi (Revision-3) shall have to qualify the Practical Examinations in addition to qualifying the Theory Examinations as well as the mandatory projects. The number of Practical Examinations and subjects covered for each Practical Examination are indicated in the given table :

The subjects indicated in the table will cover all the options available under each subject code and the candidates will have to appear for the practical examination in the elective subject he/she opts for Theory Examination. For example, M4 will cover both the electives - Programming & Problem Solving Through C Language and Programming through Visual Basic and the candidates who have opted to appear in C Language in the Theory Paper shall be permitted to appear for Practical Examination in C Language only and not in Visual Basic.

For being considered for appearing in the Practical Examination, the candidate should have completed the studies for relevant modules / papers covering the practical examination and should have applied to appear in the examination for the same modules. To qualify for appearing in PR I of 'A' Level the candidate must have applied to appear in the examinations in all the 4 modules covering the first practical (i.e. A1-R3, A2-R3, A3-R3, A4-R3) and also for appearing in practical examination. Similarly for appearing in PR-IV of 'B' level the candidate must have applied for appearing in Examination in papers (B4.3-R3, B4.4-R3 AND B4.5-R3) and also the Practical Examination.

Candidates who have switched over from Old Syllabus to New Syllabus, i.e. to 3rd Revision, shall be exempted in the practical examination as per the following rules :

O LEVEL:

If a candidate has switched over to new Syllabus (Revision 3), after clearing two or more Modules in old Syllabus, he./she will be exempted from appearing in the Practical Examination. In all other cases, the candidate will have to clear Practical Examination. For appearing in the Practical Examination, the

candidate must have applied for the examination in all the remaining modules, and submitted the requisite fee for Practical Examination.

A LEVEL:

Practical I

- a) If a candidate has passed 2 or more than 2 papers out of first 4 papers of 'A' level in old Syllabus before switching over to new Syllabus (revision 3) he / she will be exempted from appearing in the Practical I of 'A' Level.
- b) The candidates who have qualified the Practical at 'O' level will also be exempted from Practical I at 'A' Level.
- c) For appearing in Practical I the candidate must have applied for all remaining papers out of all first 4 papers and should also have submitted requisite fee for Practical I examination.

Practical II

- a) A candidate, who has cleared more than half the number of papers relevant to Practical II i.e. A5 to A10 in the old Syllabus before switching over to new Syllabus, will be exempted from appearing in Practical II of 'A' level.
- b) For appearing in Practical II examination a candidate must have applied for all the remaining papers covering Practical II (Papers A-5 to A-10) and also submitted requisite fee for Practical II Examination

It is clarified that exemption from Practical II of 'A' level shall not automatically exempt the candidate from Practical I unless he is independently eligible for exemption from Practical I. To clarify if a candidate has passed 3 papers out of last 6 papers (A5-A10) but has cleared no paper or less than 2 papers out of first 4 papers (A1-A4) he will have to clear Practical I though he would get exemption from Practical II.

B LEVEL:

Practical I & II

- a) The eligibility criteria for first two Practicals i.e. Practical I & II the criteria and exemptions shall be same as in case of corresponding Practicals of 'A' Level.

Practical III & IV

- a) The candidate who has cleared 2 or more papers out of the papers relevant to practical III (i.e. B 3.3. to B 3.5) before switching over to new syllabus shall be exempted from Practical III. Similarly the candidates who have cleared 2 or more papers out of the papers relevant to Practical IV (i.e. B4.3 to B4.5) before switching over to new syllabus shall be exempted from Practical IV.
- b) For appearing in Practical Examination a candidate must have applied from appearing in all left out papers relevant to specific Practical i.e. B 3.3. to B 3.5 for Practical III and B 4.3 to B 4.5 for Practical IV and should have applied for appearing in the practical examination.

Seminar on 'Quality IT Education in the Non-formal Sector – Awareness Creation about DOEACC activities'

A one day Seminar on "Quality IT Education in the Non-formal Sector – Awareness Creation about DOEACC activities" was organized at Hotel Shivalaya, Pudukkottai, to celebrate the inauguration of the DOEACC Regional Office at Pudukkottai.

Representatives from the Non-Formal IT education sector and eminent academicians, besides the local IT industry participated in the Seminar.

Initiating the proceedings, Dr. P.N. Gupta, Executive Director, DOEACC Society gave a PowerPoint presentation titled 'An Introduction to the activities of the DOEACC Society'. He explained to the audience the achievements of the DOEACC Society and how the Society assures the quality of IT education in its endeavour to generate quality manpower for the Indian IT industry.

DOEACC Centre, Gorakhpur

DOEACC, Gorakhpur Centre's forte is the quality delivery of long-term courses in the formal sector and short-term courses in the non-formal sector in the area of Electronics Design, besides the conduct of DOEACC Courses. The Centre has also launched courses in Bio-informatics at 'O' and 'A' Levels.

With a view to improve upon the productivity of unemployed youths at Gorakhpur as also considering the "location specific" requirements, the Centre has launched a one year diploma course in Computer Hardware and Networking and a six month diploma course in Hardware System Maintenance for 10+2 students.

Trainings were also imparted to 56 undergraduate students on Red Hat Linux Certification Programme. Insofar as corporate training schemes are concerned, ten officers of the North Eastern Railways, Gorakhpur were trained on Database Management Systems / Oracle 9i with Developer 2000 softwares.

To keep pace with the emerging technologies, the Centre has successfully conducted a seven-day programme on "Cyber Law and IPR Issues. This programme was based on the IT Act 2000 on Information Security. 21 participants from a number of states such as Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra etc., participated in the said programme.

Code of Ethics to be followed by Institutes accredited for DOEACC Courses

Following codes, applicable to the Education Institutions will be complied with by the institute accredited to run DOEACC courses.

- NOT knowingly advertise, which is liable to project a false impression of competence, the Institution;
- NOT advertise accreditation of aspects/courses not granted to the institution, either directly or by Implication: this covers those whose accreditation is under consideration or expired or withdrawn,
- NOT exaggerate the contents of the courses for which accreditation has been granted, to gain unfair advantage;
- NOT mention connection with foreign collaboration directly or indirectly to gain advantage, unless there is indisputable proof of such connection;
- NOT guarantee benefits to students that are actually false or not feasible
- NOT project price terms that are false, or misleading, to gain advantage over competition
- NOT disparage competition, even obliquely;
- NOT project insufficiently supported claims of excellence in connection with employment;
- NOT distort statement of Govt. for own gain;

- NOT criticize action of Govt./professional bodies or experts, without proper investigation;
- NOT make statement offensive to the public: including advertisements that are “Off-Colour”;
- NOT make statement of an ambiguous nature presenting a false picture in any stage / part of the scheme of accreditation including hardware / software as also omissions and half-truths;
- NOT do comparative advertising or “trade puffing”; and
- NOT involve in any other matter/action repugnant to the spirit of ethical practices. On including, behaviour to by/our students; unauthorized use of copyrighted software etc.

Wrong use of DOEACC Logo

It has been observed that some of the institutes are using the DOEACC Logo on their Letter Heads alongwith their names, which is not correct. This practice of using DOEACC Logo should be stopped forthwith by the Institutes.

Letters has been written to some of the institutes where the practice has been noticed. Other institutes may please refrain from using DOEACC Logo alongwith their names.

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
